

A: There is a feature called "HTML-mode" that allows you to get HTML code from bookmarked websites. The "view" of this HTML-mode should look something like this: If you open this URL you can download the file (you'll get an HTML page in your browser that contains the code you want to download). So, in order to download the actual PDF you need to follow these steps: Copy the above URL. Open the new URL with your browser. Save the file you get in the newly opened tab. The Ministry of Justice said nine of the inmates had been charged with murder, while 12 others were suspected of murder and other charges related to the jail's security. The remainder of the inmates were being investigated for a variety of other offences, the ministry said. Bangkok's Pathum Thani district is notorious for having a high crime rate and also being the location of two high-profile criminal cases of previous months. Seven of the detainees were arrested in a raid on Thursday and were being held in a different prison, the ministry said. The ministry is trying to find a third prisoner, who escaped from the Pathum Thani prison in the week-long riots. Pathum Thani is also the location of a former military court, and the government has accused retired senior officers of failing to help quell the unrest. It is not clear when the inmates were locked up in the prison, but the riots began on Thursday and continued on Friday and Saturday. The Thai government took steps to restrict the activities of inmates in the jail, a Bangkok Post report said. The jail's chief deputy inspector said the riots lasted at least five hours and were punctuated by frequent gunfire. Thailand's ministry of justice has released a photo taken by a witness inside the Pathum Thani Prison where more than 50 inmates are in custody following an uprising. th The rioting inmates broke out of their cells during the previous week, and the rioting in the prison turned into a shootout that resulted in the death of at least one prisoner. The fights broke out in the Tha Ma Nah prison on April 12, and lasted for about five hours. One prisoner died during the clashes and another was injured. 2d92ce491b
